### **SUMMARY**

Since May 2013, I have been serving as Senior Assistant Librarian Gr-I at the same university. From February 2001 to December 2018 and November 2019 to May 2020, I served as the Acting Librarian of the KDU Library.

Furthermore introduced an Online Public Access Catalogue, a separate library web page, an electronic Library News Letter, and a new security system with CCTV systems and security gates with tattle tapes, and also it extended the floor area of the main library and changed the layout and interior design to increase the seating capacity, introduced two branch libraries and one faculty library as a solution for the increased demand, also done during this period.
